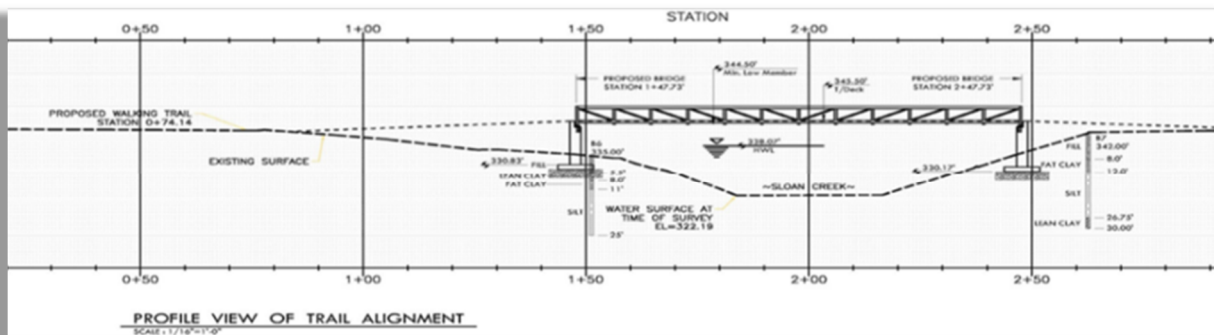
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Riverwalk Trail Phase IV a Local Public agency (LPA) administered project consisted of approximately 2000 linear feet of public sidewalk/trail and a 100 feet span pedestrian bridge over Sloan's Creek, a tributary to the Mississippi River. This project required floodplain development permitting, no-rise certifications, and 404 Permit/40 Clearance with the Army Corps of Engineers. The Project is an integral part of the City's hiking/biking Master Trail plan and highlights BFA's project management and communication capabilities to manage a project with numerous stakeholders.
